Information for Parents & Explorer Scouts -

Booking is essential and Numbers are limited. So 1st come 1st Serve.

If the weekend is oversubscribed, names will be placed on a reserve list. In the event of additional sufficient numbers applying, ScoutsNI may run an additional training weekend before the Christmas break.

Arrival is on Friday 17th November between 7pm and 7:30pm and will finish for 3:30pm on Sunday 19th November 2017

The cost of the weekend is £25 – fee to accompany form – Cheque / Card payment over the phone.

All participants must be active Young Leaders working in a section (Beavers Cubs or Scouts) and have completed Module A of the scheme

The following modules will be completed during the weekend

- Module B Taking the Lead! (Leadership styles and uses)
- Module C That's the way to do it! (How to put across ideas to others)
- Module D Kids Behaving Badly (dealing with disruptive Young People)
- Module E Game on! (Using games in the section)
- Module F Making Scouting Accessible (adapting activities for different needs)
- Module G Programme Plans (How to put together a programme)
- Module H Programme Plans Plus (A continuation of Module G)
- Module I What did they say? (Communication within the section)

The course will also include

- Missions – Awards for Young Leaders only and how to complete them
- Support for Young Leaders when working in the sections

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Accommodation is indoors but all should bring their sleeping bag. All food is provided.

Attendance is for the whole course and allowances unfortunately cannot be made for Saturday sports etc. The course begins on Friday night and runs right through to Sunday afternoon.

The weekend is a training course which is active including elements which are outdoors. All young leaders should be prepared for all weather types i.e. bring waterproofs and warm clothing. Clothing may get wet and muddy so older clothing is advised

Other kit to consider – head torch, change of footwear for indoors,

Young Leaders will be grouped with those who are working in the same section i.e. all the Cub Young Leaders will be together so they can share ideas and experiences, and not necessarily with friends from the same Explorer Unit

Please ensure participants bring any personal medication and personal hygiene items

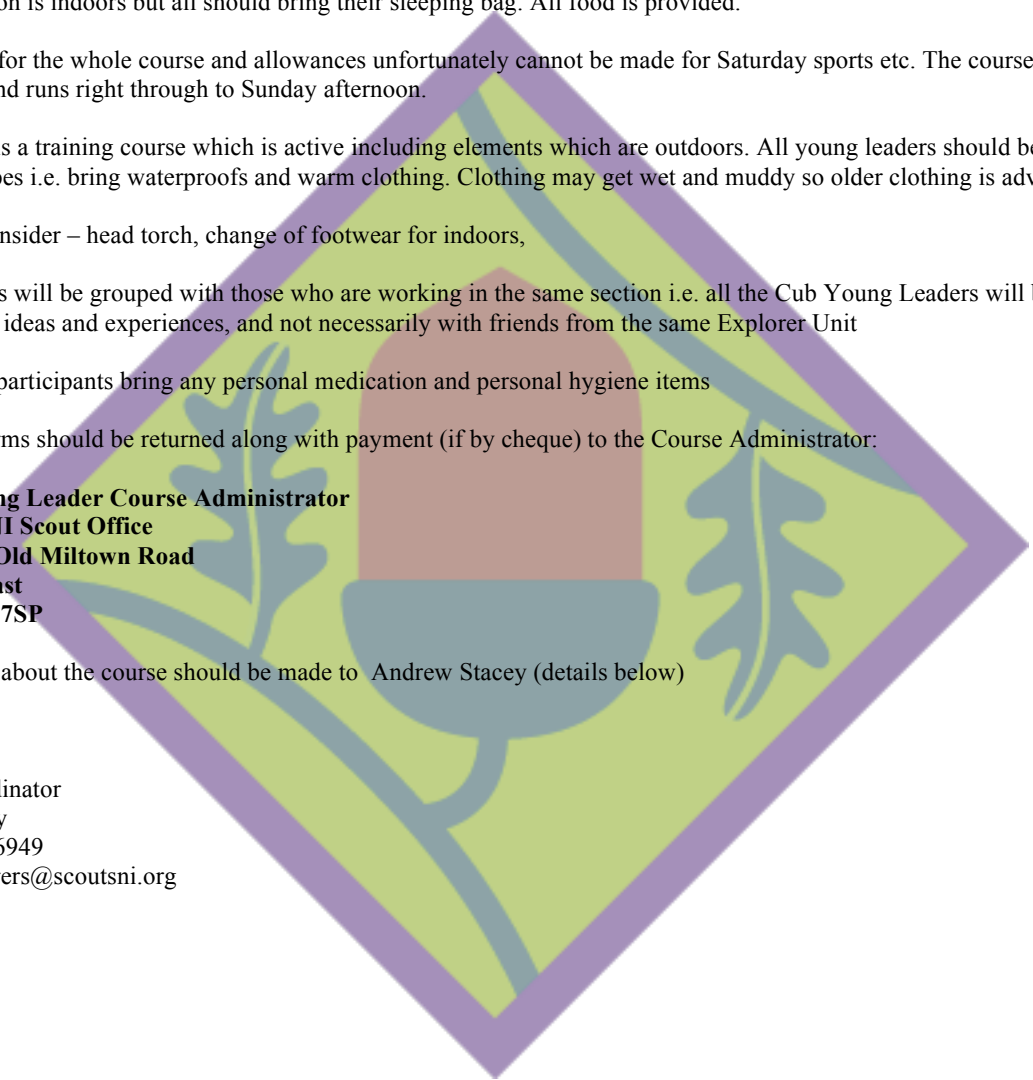
